

SNEL Umpires' Report Form – Marking Guidelines

Umpires' Changing Facilities

4 = meets stipulated standards, own showers; 3 = adequate, shared access to showers; 2 = small room, shared access to showers; 1 = room untidy, used to store gear; 0 = none available

Scoreboard/clock

4 = clearly visible; 3 = mostly visible; 2 = partly visible; 1 = too small; 0 = no clock or scoreboard not working with no alternative

Pitch covers

4 = mobile used every week, covers pitch and 4 metres back from bowling crease; 3 = mobile, covers pitch and surround; 2 = covers pitch only; 1 = inadequate, rarely used; 0 = none available

Boundaries

4 = marked with rope or fence; 3 = marked with post and rails; 2 = line and flags; 1 = line only; 0 = no markings

Roller available

4 = choice of two weights readily accessible offered; 3 = choice of two weights; 2 = one roller; 1 = not easily accessible; 0 = no roller

Sawdust available

4 = sufficient good quality; 3 = sufficient variable quality; 2 = not enough good quality; 1 = wood chip; 0 = none

Spare balls available

4 = minimum of 8 all different wear; 3 = 5 to 7 balls; 2 = 3 to 4 balls; 1 = 1 to 2 balls; 0 = none available

Separate table

4 = table laid for 4 (including scorers); 3 = table laid for 2 (umpires only); 2 = for 4 but not laid up; 0 = no separate table
